A website for CityZen was established shortly after the start of the project. It is located at <https://wiki.met.no/cityzen/start> and is continuously updated during the project. The website is based on wiki format and can, in principle, be edited by all partners of CityZen. Passwords have been issued to all partners of CityZen and the European Commission.

The ‘Home’ page lists contact details (coordinator, officers), the partners involved, and links to a short introduction to the project (pdf file).

Several pages are linked to through the menu to the left:

- **Objectives:** Describes the objectives of the project and the hypotheses to be tested.
- **News:** List of news in chronological order (all latest news and a selection of older news).
- **Meetings:** List of project meetings, including links to meeting pages (some of them are password-protected)
- **Results:** List of results, including links to results pages and deliverables (some of them are password-protected).
- **Publications:** List of publications, both within CityZen and beyond.
- **Restricted Area:** Contains administrative and other confidential information, open to the Consortium and the Commission.
- **Miscellaneous:** Items that do not belong to any of the above categories, e.g. links to our sister project MEGAPOLI.

Addition October 2009:

A new webpage has been established at <http://www.cityzen-project.eu> with a more appealing layout. It is designed for non-scientists, but contains a link to the wiki website of CityZen described above.

Addition March 2010:

The webpage at <http://www.cityzen-project.eu> only contains a brief description of the project, its objectives, news and publications. The presentation of scientific project results and exchange of restricted data among CityZen partners still occurs through the wiki page.
